■ Basic Application Requirements (Please refer to the website for further details)

Applicants must meet all of the following requirements:

1. Be a citizen of a country besides Japan.
2. Have completed a standard 12-year primary and secondary school education curriculum or its equivalent in a non-Japanese educational institution, or have completed such a curriculum in less than 12 years through academic acceleration (i.e., grade skipping), by the time of enrollment.
3. Have attained a score matching or exceeding the scores listed below on one of the following standard English proficiency tests (1), (2) or (3), taken after April 2017.

(1) TOEFL® iBT 72

(2) IELTS 5.5

(3) TOEIC® (Both L&R 785 and S&W 310)

**Note** Applicants that meet either of the following two conditions are exempted from Requirement 4 above, and do not need to have taken any of the English proficiency tests above. (In that case, applicants must submit evidence of their prior school education).

- (1) You have studied in an English-based curriculum at school for a **minimum of 7 years**, including **6 years** of secondary school education (Grades 7-12),
- (2) You have studied in an English-based curriculum at school for a **minimum of 10 years** in total.

Application Form	To be composed on the program website and printed out for submission.
Photo	1 photograph of your face (4cm × 3cm)
Curriculum Vitae	Official format to be downloaded and completed on the program website and printed out for submission.
High school transcript	Must indicate date of entrance, (expected) date of graduation, and grades for every term. (Submit an updated transcript at the time of application if you are a current high school student.)
Certification of University Entrance Qualification Examinations/Standardized Tests (if applicable)	If you have taken a university entrance qualification examination or a standardized test such as the SAT, the IB or the ACT, you are encouraged to submit your scores with the appropriate documentation for review by our admissions officers.
Copy of your passport	Submit one copy of the page which has your photograph, name and passport number.
Score reports of English proficiency tests (originals)	<p>Submit an official score report of the TOEFL® iBT, IELTS, or TOEIC® which indicates you have attained a score that matches or exceeds one of the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• TOEFL® iBT: 72</li> <li>• IELTS: 5.5</li> <li>• TOEIC®: Both L&amp;R 785 and S&amp;W 310</li> </ul> <p>Official score reports can be sent directly from the institution administering the test, but must reach us by the application deadline. (The TOEFL® code for Chuo University is <u>0151</u>).</p> <p>Applicants that meet one of the following conditions are exempt from submitting an English-proficiency test score. Such applicants must submit evidence of enrollment (such as a transcript or certification) in a school with an English-based curriculum.</p> <p>(1) You have studied in an English-based curriculum at school for a <b>minimum of 7 years</b> including <b>6 years</b> of secondary school education (Grades 7-12),</p> <p>(2) You have studied in an English-based curriculum at school for a <b>minimum of 10 years</b> in total.</p>
Letters of recommendation	Submit two letters of recommendation in English from two full-time teachers of a high school you attended.
A statement of purpose written in English	Download and complete the official format on the program website and print it out for submission.
