Non-Degree Programs

Chuo University offers a variety of non-degree programs for students from partner institutions and other universities abroad.



Exchange Programs (1 year or 1 semester)

Chuo University Exchange Programs offer an opportunity for international students to take courses or conduct research for 1 year or 1 semester at Chuo. This can include comprehensive Japanese language study as an integral part of the degree program at students' home institutions. Upon completion of the Exchange Program, exchange students can transfer credits and/or academic achievements gained at Chuo to their home institutions. Tailored Short-Term Programs

Chuo offers 1~4-week Tailored Short-Term Programs for its overseas partner institutions. Tailored Short-Term Programs held in recent years include:

- Japanese Language Program (3 weeks) for Kyung Hee University, South Korea
- Japanese Law Program (1 week) for Thammasat University, Thailand
- Japanese Language and Culture Program (2 weeks) for Southern Taiwan University of Science and Technology, Taiwan

Introduction to Japanese Law in English

This program is offered by the Chuo Law School each summer for law students from around the world. All lectures are in English. The Program includes optional study visits to law firms, courts and museums. No academic credit is offered for this program; however, those who complete the course are eligible to receive a certificate of participation.

Global FLP Program

The Global Faculty Linkage Program fosters global professionals with expertise and skills through practical, hands-on learning, and is a university-wide education program in which all subjects are taught in foreign languages.

Global LEAP Program

The Global LEAP Program is a cooperative, active-learning program taught entirely in English for undergraduate students, developed with 8 partner universities in 5 Asian countries. Students in the program explore the most pressing issues faced by Asian countries today through discussions in the Global Lecture Series, and are provided with internship opportunities at local companies and NGOs while studying abroad for 1 semester.



Opportunities for Chuo University Students

Study Abroad Programs

There are two main types of study-abroad programs for Chuo University students:

(1) the University's own study-abroad programs (exchange programs with partner institutions, non-exchange programs, and short-term programs); and,

(2) the use of holiday time or a leave of absence to study abroad. Every consideration is given to help students complete coursework begun abroad, receive credits for subjects studied abroad, and receive financial support from the University. Short-term study-abroad programs are treated as the equivalent of a semester-long course at Chuo University.



Unique Faculty Programs

At Chuo University, all of the faculties implement unique internship and fieldwork programs to promote university-wide education that transcends traditional systems and frameworks. The goal of the Faculty Linkage Program (FLP) is to foster a new generation of specialists in various fields of knowledge. Students in all faculties can participate in diverse activities, gain broad, specialized knowledge, and develop high-level communication skills to meet the demands of today's global society.
