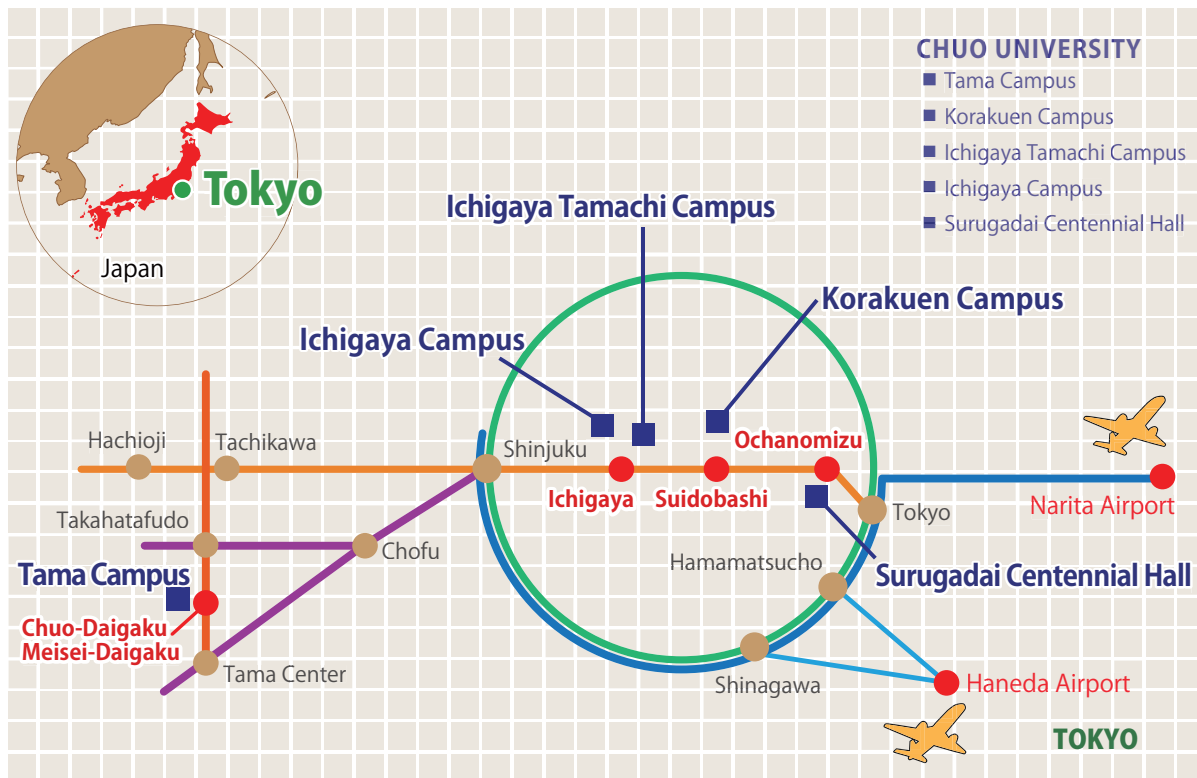


# Access to Our Campuses
